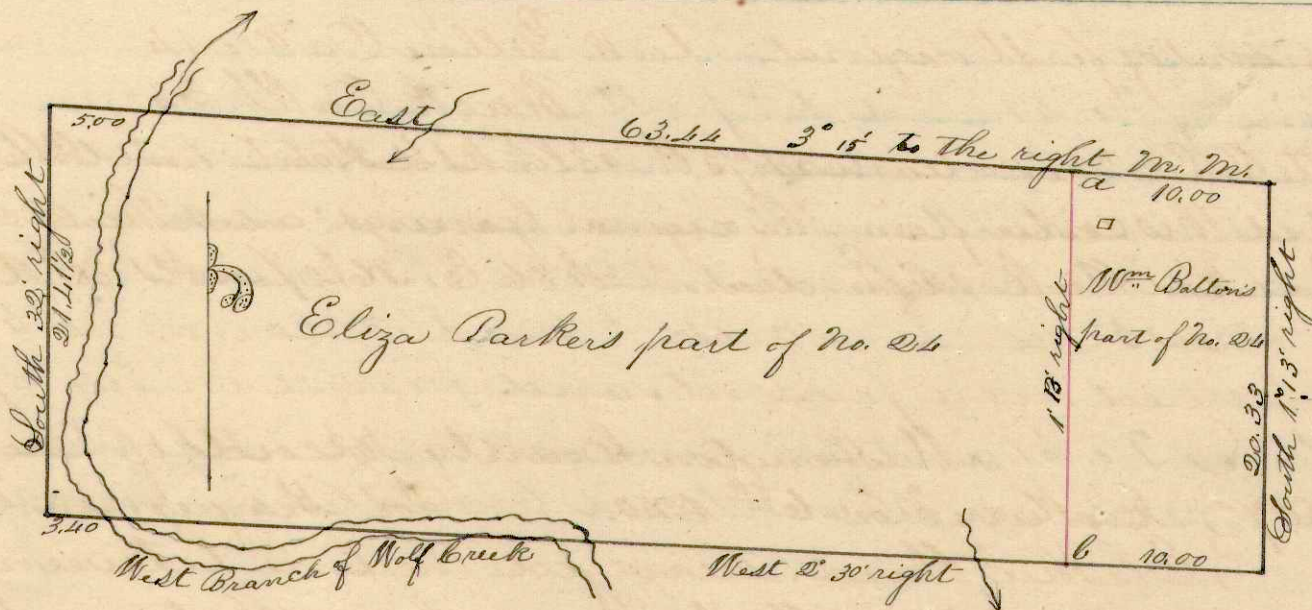


Washington County Record of Surveys Vol. 5, Page -
 Survey No. 505 3 Roxbury, Oct. 23rd 1840. Surveyed and divided Donation
 Lot No. 24 in West Branch Allotment, T. No. 8 R.
 No. 11 for Eliza Parker and M^{rs}. Bolton, agreeably to their title deed.
 The following is a Plat of said No. 24, protracted on a scale of
 ten chains to an inch.



At the N. W. corner of this Lot No. 24, the original bearings are gone. I established it at the half distance between the N. W. corner of No. 23 and the S. W. corner of No. 24; and took bearings viz. Beech 15 in diam. S. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 34 links distant; and a White Oak 30 S. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 86 links distant. Renewed the N. E. corner from the second original bearing, dead; and took a new one, viz. White Oak 29 in diam. N. 21 W. 36 links distant.

At the S. E. corner, the original bearings are standing. Renewed the S. W. corner from the original bearings, fallen; and took new bearings viz. Hickory 14 in diam. S. 67 W. 32 links distant; and a Beech 12 N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 11 links distant. At a White Oak 16 in diam. N. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 72 links distant; and White Oak 26 S. 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 64 links distant. At a White Oak 24 in diam. N. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ links distant; and Black Oak 8 N. 61 W. 17 links distant.
